Glenn has qualifications in counselling (AdDip Coun), fundraising (MInstF), and is working towards a degree in Leadership and Management.

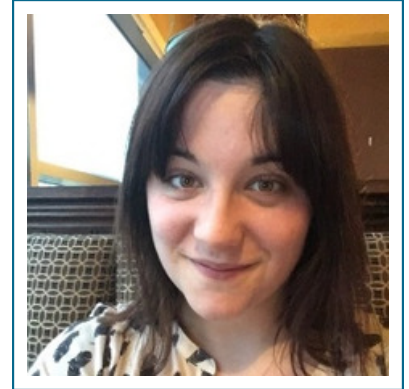

In the last 2 years, she has consulted and worked with more than 800 young people in Edinburgh.

Event Details

Positive Transitions is a project that helps young people during their first year at high school to make a positive start to secondary education. We will describe the process we used when consulting and working with over 600 young people and discuss the next steps to develop a service for young people that will help future generations moving to high school and give them the most positive start as they begin secondary school.

Positive Transitions will work with disadvantaged young people across the SIMD, the 15% most deprived data-zones in south-east/north Edinburgh, requiring intensive support during their first year at high school to make a positive start to secondary education. School staff and police have identified an annual cohort of 40-60 children moving from P7-S1 who are living in poverty or situations of deprivation; display behavioural or psychological difficulties; and/or are distressed, abused, or neglected.
